It has been known for years in the leather business for its wonderful, elegant qualities, most of all its pearled effect, caused by the points left on the skin where the bird's feathers have been plucked, giving it a polka dot pattern (this operation is called "pearl").

Its uniqueness comes from the thickness of the leather, which nevertheless remains amazingly soft and is very long-lasting and resilient. For example: an item made from genuine ostrich skin lasts on average about 30 years, while an item made of calf skin will last an average of only 5-6 years. In addition, this leather is unbelievably flexible, waterproof and easy to hand-work, dye and sew and, above all, it is wonderful to manufacture, a quality which makes it extremely attractive to

designers.

Real ostrich handbags are much more waterproof than real crocodile handbags.

Ostrich skin is characterized by its unusual design. The follicles on the leather give this skin a unique appearance and make its structure different to other leathers. The quantity of follicles dictates the price of the ostrich skin: the more follicles that are present on the leather, the higher its price. The number of follicles on the leather is constant, so the leather of an adult ostrich will approximately have the same structure and also the same quantity of follicles as the leather of a young ostrich.

The best leather is the skin obtained from birds of around 10 -14 months old because the skin at this age is already completely developed but it hasn't yet been damaged by parasites or lesions. The total quantity of leather obtainable from an ostrich of 10-14 months old is 1,1-1,5-2 m.

Handbags made from genuine ostrich leather don't require any certificates, which makes it easier and faster to ship them all over the world without any problems passing through customs.
